PRODUCT DETAILS

Galvanised Smooth Bore Flexible Tubing has been developed for applications requiring the strength and flexibility of stripwound metal hose together with an improved internal flow path.

Manufactured from specially formed, helically wound galvanised steel strip, the reduced internal profile creates a considerably smoother passage than conventional stripwound tubing. This helps minimise internal obstruction and provides a clearer route for air and conveyed materials.

The tubing is particularly suited to extraction, airflow and material handling applications involving dust, sawdust, metal swarf, powders, granules and plastic pellets.

Its flexible metallic construction also provides an effective alternative to rigid pipework where installations need to accommodate bends, vibration, movement, misalignment or restricted spaces.

Whitehouse can also manufacture non-standard tubing and bespoke products to meet individual application requirements.

Galvanised Smooth Bore Flexible Tubing is a specially developed stripwound flexible metal hose with a reduced internal profile. It provides a smoother internal passage than conventional stripwound tubing while retaining the flexibility and mechanical advantages of metallic construction.

What is the main advantage of Smooth Bore Flexible Tubing?

Its principal advantage is the smoother internal flow path. This can improve the passage of air and conveyed materials and reduce opportunities for particles to catch or accumulate within the hose.

How is Smooth Bore different from conventional stripwound tubing?

Smooth Bore uses a specially developed strip profile designed to create a substantially smoother internal surface, making it



particularly suited to extraction, airflow and material conveyance applications.

What is Galvanised Smooth Bore Flexible Tubing used for?

Typical applications include dust and sawdust extraction, metal swarf extraction, powder and granular material handling, plastic pellet conveyance, industrial vacuum systems, air ducting, fume extraction and connections to industrial machinery.

Is Galvanised Smooth Bore suitable for dust extraction?

Yes. Its smoother internal profile makes it particularly suitable for dust and particulate extraction because there are fewer pronounced internal areas where material can collect.

Can it be used for sawdust and wood chips?

Yes. Galvanised Smooth Bore Flexible Tubing can be considered for woodworking extraction systems handling sawdust and wood chips, subject to the operating conditions of the installation.

Can Galvanised Smooth Bore be used for metal swarf?

Its metallic construction makes it suitable for consideration in applications involving metal chips and swarf. The exact construction should be selected according to the size, shape, temperature and abrasiveness of the material being conveyed.

Is it suitable for powders and granules?

Yes. The smoother internal passage makes it particularly useful for conveying compatible powders, granules and plastic pellets where flexibility and reduced internal obstruction are important.

Can Galvanised Smooth Bore Flexible Tubing improve airflow?

The smoother internal profile can reduce some of the flow disturbance associated with more heavily profiled flexible tubing. Actual airflow performance will depend on the diameter, length, bends, flow velocity and overall system design.
